## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to bingo games and games using pull-tab tickets
2 conducted by qualified organizations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 99B.7, subsection 1, unnumbered
- 2 paragraph 1, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 Except as otherwise provided in section 99B.8, games of
- 4 skill, games of chance, games using pull-tab tickets, and
- 5 raffles lawfully may be conducted at a specified location
- 6 meeting the requirements of subsection 2 of this section, but
- 7 only if all of the following are complied with:
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 99B.7, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code
- 9 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 b. No person receives or has any fixed or contingent right
- 11 to receive, directly or indirectly, any profit, remuneration,
- 12 or compensation from or related to a game of skill, game of
- 13 chance, game using pull-tab tickets, or raffle, except any
- 14 amount which the person may win as a participant on the same
- 15 basis as the other participants. A person conducting a game
- 16 or raffle shall not be a participant in the game or raffle.
- 17 Sec. 3. Section 99B.7, subsection 1, paragraph c,
- 18 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2001, is amended to read as
- 19 follows:
- 20 Cash or merchandise prizes may be awarded in the game of
- 21 bingo and, except as otherwise provided in this paragraph,
- 22 shall not exceed one hundred dollars. Merchandise prizes may
- 23 be awarded in the game of bingo, but the actual retail value
- 24 of the prize, or if the prize consists of more than one item,
- 25 unit or part, the aggregate retail value of all items, units
- 26 or parts, shall not exceed the maximum provided by this
- 27 paragraph. A Not more than two jackpot bingo game games may
- 28 be conducted once during any twenty-four-hour twenty-four-hour
- 29 period in which the prize may begin at not more than three
- 30 four hundred dollars in cash or actual retail value of
- 31 merchandise prizes and may be increased by not more than one
- 32 hundred dollars after each bingo occasion. However, the cost
- 33 of play in a jackpot bingo game shall not be increased and the
- 34 jackpot shall not amount to more than eight hundred dollars in
- 35 cash or actual retail value of merchandise prizes. A jackpot

- 1 bingo game is not prohibited by paragraph "h". A bingo
- 2 occasion shall not last for longer than four consecutive
- 3 hours. A qualified organization shall not hold more than
- 4 fourteen bingo occasions per month. Bingo occasions held
- 5 under a limited license shall not be counted in determining
- 6 whether a qualified organization has conducted more than
- 7 fourteen bingo occasions per month, nor shall bingo occasions
- 8 held under a limited license be limited to four consecutive
- 9 hours. With the exception of a limited license bingo, no more
- 10 than three bingo occasions per week shall be held within a
- 11 structure or building and only one person licensed to conduct
- 12 games under this section may hold bingo occasions within a
- 13 structure or building. A licensed qualified organization
- 14 shall not conduct free games.
- 15 Sec. 4. Section 99B.7, subsection 1, paragraph d, Code
- 16 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- d. Cash prizes shall not be awarded in games other than
- 18 bingo, games using pull-tab tickets, and raffles. The value
- 19 of a prize shall not exceed one thousand dollars and
- 20 merchandise prizes shall not be repurchased. If a prize
- 21 consists of more than one item, unit, or part, the aggregate
- 22 value of all items, units, or parts shall not exceed one
- 23 thousand dollars. However, one raffle may be conducted per
- 24 calendar year at which prizes having a combined value of more
- 25 than one thousand dollars may be awarded. If the prize is
- 26 merchandise, its value shall be determined by purchase price
- 27 paid by the organization or donor.
- Sec. 5. Section 99B.7, subsection 1, paragraph 1,
- 29 subparagraph (2), Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 30 (2) No free prize or other gift is given to a participant.
- 31 However, one or more door prizes of a value not to exceed ten
- 32 thirty dollars each may be given by random drawing.
- 33 Sec. 6. Section 99B.7, subsection 2, unnumbered paragraph
- 34 1, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 35 Games of skill, games of chance, games using pull-tab

- 1 tickets, and raffles may be conducted on premises owned or
- 2 leased by the licensee, but shall not be conducted on rented
- 3 premises unless the premises are rented from a person licensed
- 4 under this section, and unless the net rent received is
- 5 dedicated to one or more of the uses permitted under
- 6 subsection 3 for dedication of net receipts. This subsection
- 7 shall not apply where the rented premises are those upon which
- 8 a qualified organization usually carries out a lawful business
- 9 other than operating games of skill, games of chance, games
- 10 using pull-tab tickets, or raffles. However, a qualified
- ll organization may rent premises other than from a licensed
- 12 qualified organization to be used for the conduct of games of
- 13 skill, games of chance, games using pull-tab tickets, and
- 14 raffles, and the person from whom the premises are rented may
- 15 impose and collect rent for such use of those premises, but
- 16 only if all of the following are complied with:
- 17 Sec. 7. Section 99B.7, subsection 4, Code 2001, is amended
- 18 by striking the subsection.
- 19 Sec. 8. Section 99B.7, subsection 8, Code 2001, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 8. A qualified organization licensed under this section
- 22 shall purchase games using pull-tab tickets and bingo
- 23 equipment and supplies only from a manufacturer or a
- 24 distributor licensed by the department.
- 25 Sec. 9. Section 99B.7A, Code 2001, is amended to read as
- 26 follows:
- 27 99B.7A MANUFACTURERS AND DISTRIBUTORS OF PULL-TAB GAMES OR
- 28 BINGO EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES -- LICENSE.
- 29 A person shall not engage in business as a manufacturer or
- 30 a distributor of games using pull-tab tickets or bingo
- 31 equipment and supplies in this state without first obtaining a
- 32 license from the department. Upon receipt of an application
- 33 and a fee of one thousand dollars for a manufacturer's license
- 34 or a fee of five hundred dollars for a distributor's license,
- 35 the department shall issue an annual license as applicable.

1 The application shall be submitted on forms furnished by the 2 department and contain the information required by rule of the 3 department. A license may be renewed annually upon payment of 4 the annual license fee and compliance with this chapter. 5 **EXPLANATION** This bill amends provisions relating to qualified 7 organizations conducting bingo games and authorizes qualified 8 organizations to conduct games using pull-tab tickets. The bill authorizes qualified organization licensees to 10 conduct two jackpot bingo games during any 24-hour period at a 11 minimum value of \$400 each. Currently, a licensee may have 12 one jackpot bingo game at a minimum value of \$300. 13 Also, the bill strikes the provision that if a qualified 14 organization licensee derives 90 percent or more of its total 15 income from bingo, raffles, and small games of chance, at 16 least 75 percent of the licensee's net receipts shall be 17 distributed to an unrelated entity for an educational, civic, 18 public, charitable, patriotic, or religious use. The bill also authorizes certain qualified organization 20 licensees to offer door prizes with a value of \$30 each in 21 lieu of \$10 each under current law. The bill authorizes certain qualified organizations to 22 23 conduct games using pull-tab tickets. The pull-tabs must be 24 purchased from a licensed manufacturer or distributor in the 25 same manner as bingo equipment and supplies are purchased. 26 The manufacturers and distributors are licensed by the 27 department of inspections and appeals. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
