- 7 In 1999, the general assembly enacted House File 322 (1999
- 8 Iowa Acts, chapter 169) that regulated the relationship
- 9 between an agricultural producer (contract producer) and the
- 10 owner of a commodity (contractor) in which the producer
- 11 produced a commodity under contract. In part, the Act created
- 12 Code chapter 579B providing for a lien upon commodities
- 13 produced at a contractor producer's contract operation in
- 14 favor of the contract producer. The chapter was based on Code
- 15 chapter 579A which allows a custom cattle feedlot operator to
- 16 file a lien on cattle produced at a custom cattle feedlot.
- 17 Generally a lien created under these chapters is superior to

1 filing a financing statement. The article provides for the 2 contents of financing statements and the location where such 3 financing statements must be filed (e.g., with the secretary 4 of state). In perfecting a security interest, a debtor is 5 generally assured rights in the collateral superior to a 6 security interest perfected later in time. Prior to the revision of article 9, liens created in 8 statutes outside Code chapter 554 were not affected by its 9 provisions. These liens include types of agricultural liens 10 such as those created in Code chapters 579A and 579B. 11 chapter 579A, the lien is created at the time the cattle 12 arrive at a feedlot, and must be preserved by filing a lien 13 statement with the secretary of state within 20 days. 14 Code chapter 579B, the lien is created at the time the 15 livestock arrive at a contract operation or the time that the 16 crop is planted, and must be preserved by filing a lien 17 statement with the secretary of state. Revised article 9 18 provides filing requirements for perfecting agricultural liens 19 and therefore may control issues relating to priority of 20 conflicting security interests and liens. 21 The bill amends both Code chapters 579A and 579B by 22 eliminating requirements for filing that are inconsistent with 23 the requirements contained in revised article 9. 24 expressly states that the two types of liens are agricultural 25 liens, replaces references to lien statements with financing 26 statements, and provides for their super-priority status over 27 other security interests and liens with the exception of 28 veterinarian liens to the extent that these liens also have 29 been perfected as agricultural liens under revised article 9. 30 The bill provides that where a production contract provides 31 for continuous arrival of livestock at a contract operation, 32 the contract producer must file a financing statement within 33 180 days from the date of arrival. The bill provides for the 34 priority of competing liens perfected as required under

35 revised article 9, or effective but not perfected under the

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1 article by following the first-in-time rule adopted under the
2 uniform commercial code.

#### DIVISION I

#### CUSTOM CATTLE FEEDLOT LIEN

Section 1. Section 579A.1, Code 2001, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. "Lien" means a custom cattle feedlot lien created in section 579A.2.
