- 1 Section 1. Section 331.655, subsection 1, paragraphs a, b,
- 2 c, e, f, g, h, k, l, m, and n, Code 2001, are amended to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 a. For serving a notice and returning it, for the first

- 6 person, ten fifteen dollars except the fee for serving
