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## A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for congressional and legislative districts and 2 providing an effective date.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 40.1, Code 2001, is amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
40.1 CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS.

The state of Iowa is hereby organized and divided into five congressional districts, which shall be composed,
respectively, of the following counties:

1. The first district shall consist of the counties of Clayton, Delaware, Dubuque, Linn, Jones, Jackson, Clinton, Cedar, and Scott.
2. The second district shall consist of the counties of Jasper, Poweshiek, Warren, Marion, Mahaska, Keokuk, Washington, Johnson, Louisa, Muscatine, Union, Clarke, Lucas, Monroe, Wapello, Jefferson, Henry, Des Moines, Decatur, Wayne, Appanoose, Davis, Van Buren, and Lee.
3. The third district shall consist of the counties of Emmet, Kossuth, Winnebago, Worth, Mitchell, Howard, Winneshiek, Allamakee, Hancock, Cerro Gordo, Floyd, Chickasaw,
 Hamilton, Hardin, Grundy, Black Hawk, Buchanan, Tama, Benton, and Iowa.
4. The fourth district shall consist of the counties of Greene, Boone, Story, Marshall, Dallas, Polk, and Madison.
5. The fifth district shall consist of the counties of Lyon, Osceola, Dickinson, Sioux, O'Brien, Clay, Palo Alto, Plymouth, Cherokee, Buena Vista, Pocahontas, Woodbury, Ida, Sac, Calhoun, Monona, Crawford, Carroll, Harrison, Shelby, Audubon, Guthrie, Pottawattamie, Cass, Adair, Mills, Montgomery, Adams, Fremont, Page, Taylor, and Ringgold.

Sec. 2. Section 41.1, Code 2001, is amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
41.1 REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS.

The state of Iowa is hereby divided into one hundred representative districts as follows:

Sec. 4. VACANCIES.

1. MEMBER OF CONGRESS. If a special election to fill a vacancy for a representative in Congress occurs or exists after the effective date of this Act, at a time which makes it necessary to fill the vacancy at a special election held pursuant to section 69.14, the vacancy shall be filled from the same district provided in chapter 40 , Code 2001, which section 69.14
2. MEMBER OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY. If a vacancy in the general assembly occurs or exists after the effective date of this Act, at a time which makes it necessary to fill the vacancy at a special election held pursuant to section 69.14, the vacancy shall be filled from the same district provided in chapter 41, Code 2001, which elected the senator or representative whose seat is vacant. This section does not apply if a special election is not required under section 69.14.
3. REPEAL. This section is repealed January l, 2003.

Sec. 5. GEOGRAPHY. For purposes of this Act, each reference to a specific city or township means the city or township as its boundary existed on January l, 2000, the official date for establishing such boundaries under the 2000 United States decennial census. Also, for purposes of this Act, such reference to a street or other boundary means such street or boundary as they are delineated on the official Public Law 94-17l census maps.

Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

EXPLANATION
This bill establishes congressional and legislative

3 provides that state senate districts are composed of two state
4 representative districts and specifies which numbered
