1 Section 1. COUNTY SIGN REPLACEMENT. The state department  
2 of transportation shall conduct an analysis of the condition,  
3 readability, and adequacy of size of general information signs  
4 which mark county lines and which are currently posted along  
5 interstate highways in the state. The department shall  
6 replace such signs that do not meet reasonable readability and  
7 size standards or that are in poor condition.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill directs the state department of transportation to  
10 conduct an analysis of the condition, readability, and  
11 adequacy of size of general information signs which mark  
12 county lines and which are currently posted along interstate  
13 highways in the state. The bill also directs the department  
14 to replace such signs that do not meet reasonable readability  
15 and size standards or that are in poor condition.
