Section 1. Section 272C.2A, Code 2001, is amended to read 2 as follows: 3 272C.2A CONTINUING EDUCATION MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS --4 BARBERING AND COSMETOLOGY ARTS AND SCIENCES. The board of barber examiners and the board of 6 cosmetology arts and sciences examiners, created pursuant to 7 chapter 147, shall each require, as a condition of license 8 renewal, a minimum of six hours of continuing education in the 9 two years immediately prior to a licensee's license renewal. 10 The board of cosmetology arts and sciences examiners may 11 notify cosmetology arts and sciences licensees on a quarterly 12 basis regarding continuing education opportunities. 13 2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, a licensed barber shall 14 be exempt from additional continuing education requirements as 15 a condition of license renewal provided that the licensee has 16 continuously held a license to practice barbering and been 17 engaged on a full-time basis in the practice of barbering 18 during the 20-year period immediately preceding the licensure 19 renewal date. 20 **EXPLANATION** 21 This bill provides for an exemption from continuing 22 education requirements as a condition of license renewal for 23 barbers under specified circumstances. The bill provides that 24 a barber shall be exempt from continuing education 25 requirements if the barber has continuously held a license to 26 practice barbering and been engaged on a full-time basis in 27 the practice of barbering during the 20-year period 28 immediately preceding the licensure renewal date. 29 30 31 32 33 34 35
