1 Section 1. Section 256.7, subsection 7, unnumbered  
2 paragraph 3, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 The rules shall provide that when the curriculum is taught  
4 by an appropriately licensed teacher at the location at which  
5 the telecommunications originates, the curriculum received at  
6 a remote site shall be under the supervision of a licensed  
7 teacher. The licensed teacher at the originating site may  
8 provide supervision of students at a remote site or the school  
9 district in which the remote site is located may provide for  
10 supervision at the remote site if the school district deems it  
11 necessary or if requested to do so by the licensed teacher at  
12 the originating site. For the purposes of this subsection,  
13 "supervision" means that the curriculum is monitored by a  
14 licensed teacher and the teacher is accessible to the students  
15 receiving the curriculum by means of telecommunications.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill provides that the supervision of kindergarten  
18 through grade 12 students receiving curriculum via the Iowa  
19 communications network may be provided by the licensed teacher  
20 at the originating site, or may be provided by the school  
21 district receiving the curriculum if the district decides it  
22 is advisable or if the originating site teacher requests it.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 256.7, subsection 7, unnumbered paragraph 3, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

The rules shall provide that when the curriculum is taught by an appropriately licensed teacher at the location at which the telecommunications originates, the curriculum received at a remote site shall be under the supervision of a licensed teacher. The licensed teacher at the originating site may provide supervision of students at a remote site or the school district in which the remote site is located may provide for supervision at the remote site if the school district deems it necessary or if requested to do so by the licensed teacher at the originating site.
