1 Section 1. Section 301.30, Code 2001, is amended to read 2 as follows:

3 301.30 PAYMENT OF CLAIMS FOR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL PUPIL 4 TEXTBOOK SERVICES.

5 <u>1.</u> Boards of directors of school districts shall be 6 required to provide textbook services to nonpublic school 7 pupils as provided in section 301.1 only during school years 8 when the general assembly has appropriated funds to the 9 department of education for the payment of claims for textbook 10 costs submitted by the school district.

II If-the-funds-appropriated-by-the-general-assembly-are-not sufficient-to-pay-claims-submitted-by-the-school-districts; the-amount-paid-to-each-school-district-by-the-department shall-be-prorated-on-the-basis-of-funds-so-appropriated.---The difference-between-the-amount-of-the-claim-of-a-school district-and-the-amount-of-payment-received-from-the department-of-education-shall-be-paid-by-the-parent-or guardian-of-the-nonpublic-school-pupil-served. <u>2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the</u> state to the department of education, for each fiscal year, an

21 amount necessary to pay claims submitted to the department as 22 provided in this section.

23 <u>3.</u> The costs of providing textbook services to nonpublic 24 school pupils as provided in section 301.1 shall not be 25 included in the computation of district cost under chapter 26 257, but shall be shown in the budget as an expense from 27 miscellaneous income. Any textbook reimbursements received by 28 a local school district for serving nonpublic school pupils 29 shall not affect district cost limitations of chapter 257. 30 The reimbursements provided in this section are miscellaneous 31 income as defined in section 257.2.

32 <u>4.</u> Claims for reimbursement shall be made to the 33 department of education by July 15 by the public school 34 district providing textbook services during a school year on a 35 form prescribed by the department, and the claim shall state

1 the actual costs incurred in, and the actual number of 2 nonpublic students requesting, the provision of textbook 3 services. Claims shall be accompanied by an affidavit of an 4 officer of the public school district affirming the accuracy 5 of the claim. The department shall certify to the director of 6 revenue and finance the amounts of approved claims to be paid, 7 and the director of revenue and finance shall draw warrants 8 payable to school districts which have established claims. 9 The public school district of attendance shall furnish the 10 services and shall receive reimbursement from the state. 11 However, the services must be comparable to the services of 12 the district of attendance and cannot exceed the per pupil 13 cost of the program of the district of attendance. 14 EXPLANATION 15 This bill provides full state funding for textbook services 16 school districts provide to accredited nonpublic school 17 students. Under Code section 301.1, school districts are 18 required to make available to accredited nonpublic school 19 students, upon request and to the extent funds are 20 appropriated by the general assembly, textbooks adopted and 21 purchased by the school district. 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35
