1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of 2 the State of Iowa is proposed: Section 5 of Article II of the Constitution of the State of 4 Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof: DISQUALIFIED PERSONS. Sec. 5. A person adjudged mentally 5 6 incompetent to vote or convicted of any felony shall not be 7 entitled to the privilege of an elector. Sec. 2. The foregoing amendment to the Constitution of the 9 State of Iowa is referred to the General Assembly to be chosen 10 at the next general election for members of the General 11 Assembly, and the Secretary of State is directed to cause the 12 same to be published for three consecutive months previous to 13 the date of that election as provided by law. 14 EXPLANATION 15 This joint resolution proposes an amendment to the 16 Constitution of the State of Iowa providing that conviction of 17 any felony, rather than of any infamous crime, disqualifies 18 the convicted offender from voting or holding certain elective The resolution also removes the words "idiot" and 19 offices. 20 "insane" from the constitutional provision and substitutes the 21 phrase "mentally incompetent to vote". 22 The resolution, if adopted, would be referred to the next 23 general assembly before being submitted to the electorate for 24 ratification. 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
