5	A Resolution urging the establishment of a State Task
6	Force on Employment of Iowans With Disabilities.
7	WHEREAS, many Iowans experience a physical or
8	mental impairment that substantially limits at least
9	one major life activity, and, due to this impairment,
10	some of these disabled Iowans have difficulty finding
11	or sustaining gainful employment; and
12	WHEREAS, a need exists for a coordinated and
13	aggressive state policy to bring Iowans with
14	disabilities into gainful employment at a rate as
15	close as possible to that of the general adult
16	population; and
7	WHEREAS, there is a need for a coordinated state
18	policy to reduce the barriers for Iowans with
19	disabilities in the areas of employer accommodations,
20	access to health care, transportation, accessible and
21	integrated housing, telecommunications, assistive
22	technology, community services, child care, education
2 3	vocational rehabilitation and training services,
24	workplace support, and economic incentives to work;

26	WHEREAS, to ensure that Iowa state government is a
27	model employer of adults with disabilities, the
28	Department of Personnel, the Department of Human
29	Rights, the Department of Education, Division of
30	Vocational Rehabilitation Services, the Department of

- 1 Human Services' state Independent Living Council and
- 2 Creative Employment Options, and Iowa Workforce
- 3 Development need to review state personnel laws,
- 4 regulations, and policies, and recommend or implement
- 5 changes necessary to improve employment policies for
- 6 Iowans with disabilities; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Department of Economic Development
- 8 needs to review the effort to develop small business
- 9 and entrepreneurial opportunities to assist in the
- 10 self-sufficiency of Iowans with disabilities; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation needs to
- 12 examine the programs in place to determine if existing
- 13 programs can be used to create new work incentives and
- 14 remove barriers to work for Iowans with disabilities;
- 15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health needs to
- 17 examine the measures taken pursuant to the
- 18 disabilities chapter of the Healthy Iowans 2010 plan,
- 19 and determine its efficacy as it relates to Iowans
- 20 with disabilities; and
- 21 WHEREAS, in order to coordinate the individual
- 22 efforts of the departments, a unifying entity should
- 23 be created, and a Task Force on Employment of Iowans
- 24 With Disabilities should be created to carry out the
- 25 goals of employment and gainful economic activities of
- 26 individuals with disabilities; NOW THEREFORE,
- 27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,
- 28 That the House of Representatives urges Governor
- 29 Thomas J. Vilsack to establish a Task Force on
- 30 Employment of Iowans With Disabilities, and appoint as

- 1 members the Directors of the Department of Education,
 2 Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services, the
 3 Department of Personnel, the Department of Human
- 4 Rights, the Department of Human Services' state
- 5 Independent Living Council and creative Employment
- 6 Options, the Department of Public Health, the
- 7 Department of Economic Development, the Department of
- 8 Transportation, and Iowa Workforce Development, or the
- 9 Directors' designees, and other persons knowledgeable
- 10 in these areas.
- 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a Task Force on
- 12 Employment of Iowans With Disabilities should be
- 13 charged with identifying employment issues and
- 14 exploring resolutions to barriers confronting Iowans
- 15 with Disabilities, by working with the departments and
- 16 agencies of state government as well as private sector
- 17 employers, organizations that represent persons with
- 18 disabilities, organized labor, veterans service
- 19 organizations, and county and local governments, and
- 20 further be charged with reporting to the Governor and
- 21 the General Assembly the findings and recommendations
- 22 of the Task Force.

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
