2	BY RICHARDSON and SCHRADER
3	A House Resolution requesting the United States
4	Congress to enact legislation requiring the Federal
5	Energy Regulatory Commission to regulate the price of
6	the production and transmission of natural gas.
7	WHEREAS, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
8	issued Order 380 in 1984, beginning the deregulation
9	of pipeline price and access, and completed this
10	process by issuing Order 636 in 1992; and
11	WHEREAS, the United States Congress passed the
12	Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978 which phased out the
13	regulation of natural gas wellhead prices, with total
14	deregulation being completed by January 1, 1993; and
15	WHEREAS, fifty-three percent of the 101.5 million
16	households in the United States currently use natural
17	gas for home heating; and
18	WHEREAS, eighty-three percent of the 21.6 million
19	households in the United States located in the Midwest
20	use natural gas for home heating, the highest
21	concentration in the nation; and
22	WHEREAS, natural gas is used in the production of
23	nitrogen fertilizers which Iowa and American farmers
24	rely on to maintain crop yields and low household food
25	costs; and
26	WHEREAS, the average wellhead price for natural gas
27	has increased \$1.69 per thousand cubic feet (Mcf) in
28	September 1998 to almost \$4.00 per Mcf by September
29	2000; and
30	WHEREAS, Midwest homeowners will pay almost \$2.00

- 1 per Mcf more for natural gas this winter as compared
- 2 to last winter; and
- 3 WHEREAS, total United States residential natural
- 4 gas expenditures are expected to reach \$8 billion for
- 5 the current month of January 2001; and
- 6 WHEREAS, nitrogen fertilizer producers are shutting
- 7 down production facilities and selling natural gas
- 8 stocks in order to take advantage of current high
- 9 market prices which will lead to nitrogen fertilizer
- 10 shortages and lower crop yields; and
- 11 WHEREAS, demand for natural gas will continue to
- 12 accelerate due to the preference for natural gas
- 13 heating in new home construction and for natural gas-
- 14 fired electric generation by utility companies for new
- 15 power plants coming on line and currently being
- 16 planned; and
- WHEREAS, this continuing increase in demand for
- 18 natural gas will cause prices to continue at much
- 19 higher levels than experienced in recent years; NOW
- 20 THEREFORE,
- 21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,
- 22 That the Iowa House of Representatives urges the
- 23 United States Congress to enact legislation to restore
- 24 regulation of the production and transmission of
- 25 natural gas through the Federal Energy Regulatory
- 26 Commission; and
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this
- 28 Resolution be sent to the President of the United
- 29 States, the Speaker of the United States House of
- 30 Representatives, and each member of the Iowa
