- Quarters Program, and to direct the commission to 6

- 9 WHEREAS, the United States Mint has implemented a
- 10 program in accordance with Public Law No. 105-124, to
- 11 commemorate each of the 50 states in the order in
- 12 which the states ratified the United States
- 13 Constitution and joined the Union; and
- 14 WHEREAS, each state has an opportunity to develop
- 15 and submit designs representative of the state; and
- 16 WHEREAS, quarter dollar coins have a commercial
- 17 lifespan of at least 30 years and are collected for
- 18 generations, providing an opportunity for wide
- 19 distribution of an enduring symbol of this state; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Iowa entered the Union as the twenty-ninth
- 21 state on December 28, 1846, and the quarter dollar
- 22 honoring the state of Iowa will be issued in 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Governor of Iowa will be contacted no
- 24 later than 2002 concerning Iowa's design submission;
- 25 and
- 26 WHEREAS, a special commission should be established
- 27 by the Governor to consider Iowa's design submission;
- 28 and
- 29 WHEREAS, the symbol of the State of Iowa should
- 30 reflect the agricultural heritage of this great state;
