A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to confidentiality of ethics complaints during even-numbered years. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 68B.31, Code 2001, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 9A. The ethics committee of each house 4 shall recommend rules for adoption by the respective house 5 relating to special confidentiality rules for ethics 6 complaints filed on or after May 1 of each even-numbered year. 7 The rules shall provide for a complaint, any information 8 accompanying the complaint, and any procedures related to the

9 complaint conducted by the ethics committee or staff 10 subsequent to the filing of the complaint to be kept

ll confidential if, in the best judgment of the chairperson of

12 the ethics committee, a final disposition of the complaint

13 cannot be reached prior to election day. These rules shall

14 supersede any confidentiality rules adopted pursuant to

16 the confidentiality rules adopted pursuant to subsection 9

17 shall govern all complaints currently under consideration by

19 **EXPLANATION**

20 This bill provides for special confidentiality rules to be 21 adopted relating to ethics complaints filed on or after May 1 22 of each even-numbered year. The bill provides that the rules 23 shall provide for a complaint, any information accompanying 24 the complaint, and any procedures related to the complaint 25 conducted by the ethics committee or staff subsequent to the 26 filing of the complaint to be kept confidential if, in the 27 best judgment of the chairperson of the ethics committee, a 28 final disposition of the complaint cannot be reached prior to 29 election day. The bill provides that the special 30 confidentiality rules shall supersede any regular 31 confidentiality rules until the day after election day at

32 which time the regular ethics committee confidentiality rules

33 shall govern any complaints currently under consideration by

34 the ethics committee.
