- Section 1. Section 321.34, Code 2001, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 23. CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION SPECIAL
- 4 PLATES. An owner referred to in subsection 12 who is a member
- 5 of Iowa's congressional delegation may, upon written
- 6 application to the department and presentation of satisfactory
- 7 proof of membership in such delegation, order special
- 8 registration plates with a congressional delegation processed
- 9 emblem. The emblem shall be designed by the department and
- 10 shall signify that the owner is a member of Iowa's
- 11 congressional delegation. The application is subject to
- 12 approval by the department. The special plates shall be
- 13 issued at no charge and are subject to an annual registration
- 14 fee of fifteen dollars. The county treasurer shall validate
- 15 the special plates in the same manner as regular registration
- 16 plates are validated under this section.
- 17 Special registration plates issued under this subsection
- 18 shall be surrendered to the department or the appropriate
- 19 county treasurer upon the death of or discontinuance of
- 20 service in the United States senate or house of
- 21 representatives by the vehicle owner who was initially issued
- 22 the special plates under this subsection.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 This bill authorizes the state department of transportation
- 25 to issue congressional delegation special registration plates
- 26 to persons who are members of Iowa's congressional delegation.
- 27 The plates shall display a congressional delegation processed
- 28 emblem, designed by the department, and shall be issued at no
- 29 charge, subject to an annual \$15 registration fee. Such
- 30 plates shall be turned in to the department or the appropriate
- 31 county treasurer when a person who was issued the plates dies
- 32 or discontinues service in the United States senate or house
- 33 of representatives.
