Section 1. Section 272.2, subsection 7, Code 2001, is 2 amended by striking the subsection. Sec. 2. Section 272.5, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 2001, 4 is amended by striking the unnumbered paragraph. 272.5A EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. NEW SECTION. 5 Sec. 3. The governor shall appoint an executive director of the 7 board of educational examiners subject to confirmation by the 8 senate. The executive director shall possess a background in 9 education and administrative experience and shall serve at the 10 pleasure of the governor. The executive director shall employ 11 a legal counsel and other personnel consistent with chapter 12 19A and shall control the personnel administration of persons 13 employed by the board. The governor shall set the salary of 14 the executive director within the range established for the 15 position by the general assembly. 16 EXPLANATION 17 This bill provides that the governor, rather than the board 18 of educational examiners, shall appoint the board's executive 19 director, subject to confirmation by the senate. 20 executive director shall serve at the pleasure of the 21 governor. The bill transfers responsibility for the 22 establishment of the executive director's salary from the 23 board to the governor. However, the salary range continues to 24 be that established for the position by the general assembly. 25 The bill provides that personnel employed by the director 26 shall be subject to the merit system established under Code 27 chapter 19A. 28 29 30 31
