1 Section 1. Section 708.1, subsection 2, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. Any act which is intended to place another in fear of
4 immediate imminent physical contact which will be painful,
5 injurious, insulting, or offensive, coupled with the apparent
6 ability to execute the act.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill amends the definition of assault contained in
9 Code section 708.1 by changing the phrase "place another in
10 fear of immediate physical contact" to "place another in fear
11 of imminent physical contact".

1 Section 1. Section 303.2, subsection 2, Code 2001, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. k. Administer, preserve, and interpret the
4 battle flag collection assembled by the state in consultation
5 and coordination with the department of general services.

6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill specifically authorizes the historical division
8 of the department of cultural affairs to manage the battle
9 flag collection at the state capital grounds in consultation
10 and coordination with the department of general services.
11 Current law authorizes the historical division to manage
12 historical sites generally as defined in Code section 303.2.
