# A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for a tax levy for the county hospital fund in certain counties and providing an effective date. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 347.7, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
2 2001, is amended to read as follows:

If a county hospital is established, the board of 3 4 supervisors, at the time of levying ordinary taxes, shall levy 5 a tax at the rate voted not to exceed fifty-four cents per 6 thousand dollars of assessed value in any one year for the 7 erection and equipment of the hospital, and also a tax not to 8 exceed twenty-seven cents per thousand dollars of value for 9 the improvement, maintenance, and replacements of the 10 hospital, as certified by the board of hospital trustees. 11 However, in counties having a population of two hundred 12 twenty-five thousand or over, the levy for taxes payable in 13 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1996 2001, and for 14 subsequent fiscal years, for improvements and maintenance of 15 the hospital shall not exceed one-dollar two dollars and 16 seventy-five five cents per thousand dollars of assessed value 17 in any one year. The proceeds of the taxes constitute the 18 county public hospital fund and the fund is subject to review 19 by the board of supervisors in counties over having a 20 population of two hundred twenty-five thousand or over. 21 However, the board of trustees of a county hospital, where 22 funds are available in the county public hospital fund of the 23 county which are unappropriated, may use the unappropriated 24 funds for erecting and equipping hospital buildings and 25 additions thereto to the hospital buildings without authority 26 from the voters of the county.

27 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of 28 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

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### EXPLANATION

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This bill increases the maximum property tax levy for the locunty hospital fund in counties having a population of 2225,000 or more from \$1.75 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of 33 taxable property to \$2.05 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of 34 taxable property. The revenue may be used for the improvement 35 and maintenance of the county hospital. The tax levy increase

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

This bill increases the maximum property tax levy for the county hospital fund in counties having a population of 22 225,000 or more from \$1.75 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of 33 taxable property to \$2.05 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of 34 taxable property. The revenue may be used for the improvement 35 and maintenance of the county hospital. The tax levy increase

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S.F. 186 H.F. 1 applies to taxes payable in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2 2001, and subsequent fiscal years. The bill takes effect upon enactment. 

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## SENATE FILE 186 FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for **Senate File 186** is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 186 increases the maximum property tax levy for the county hospital fund in counties having a population greater than 225,000. The levy is increased from \$1.75 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of taxable property to \$2.05 per \$1,000. The increased levy would apply to taxes payable starting in FY 2002.

### ASSUMPTIONS

- The only county in Iowa having a population greater than 225,000 is Polk County.
- 2. The FY 2001 valuation for Polk County is \$10.9 billion.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated fiscal impact of SF 186 would be to raise additional property tax revenues for Polk County of \$3.3 million.

The proceeds of the taxes constitute the county public hospital fund and the fund is subject to review by the board of supervisors in counties over having a population of two hundred twenty-five thousand or over. However, the board of trustees of a county hospital, where funds are available in the county public hospital fund of the county which are unappropriated, may use the unappropriated funds for crecting and equipping hospital buildings and additions thereto to the hospital buildings without authority from the voters of the county.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
