1 Section 1. Section 176A.9, subsection 4, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 4. The extension council may collect reasonable fees and
4 may seek and receive grants, donations, gifts, bequests, or
5 other moneys from public and private sources to be used for
6 the purposes set forth in this section, and may enter into
7 contracts to provide educational services. However, services
8 provided by the extension council to the 4-H organization and
9 its clubs in accordance with this chapter shall be provided
10 free of charge.

11 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 266.34A EXTENSION SERVICES TO 4-H.
12 Notwithstanding section 262.47, extension services provided
13 by the Iowa cooperative extension service in agriculture and
14 home economics of Iowa state university to the 4-H
15 organization and its clubs shall be provided free of charge.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill requires that extension services provided by Iowa
18 state university's Iowa cooperative extension service in
19 agriculture and home economics, or by the county agricultural
20 extension council, to the 4-H organization and its clubs must
21 be provided free of charge.
