Section 1. Section 176A.9, subsection 4, Code 2001, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 4. The extension council may collect reasonable fees and 3 4 may seek and receive grants, donations, gifts, bequests, or 5 other moneys from public and private sources to be used for 6 the purposes set forth in this section, and may enter into 7 contracts to provide educational services. However, services 8 provided by the extension council to the 4-H organization and 9 its clubs in accordance with this chapter shall be provided 10 free of charge. NEW SECTION. 266.34A EXTENSION SERVICES TO 4-H. 11 Sec. 2. 12 Notwithstanding section 262.47, extension services provided 13 by the Iowa cooperative extension service in agriculture and 14 home economics of Iowa state university to the 4-H 15 organization and its clubs shall be provided free of charge.
