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## S.F. 2029 H.F.

Section 1. Section 514C.18, subsection 1, Code 2001, is
amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

3 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. c. Medications approved by the United 4 States food and drug administration for the control of blood 5 sugar levels, including insulin and oral agents, prescribed by 6 the patient's physician.

<u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. d. Equipment and supplies necessary for
8 insulin administration, including but not limited to syringes,
9 insulin pens, insulin pumps, and related equipment.

10 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. e. Assistive devices for those who are 11 visually impaired, including voice-modulated blood glucose 12 meters and injection aids.

13 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. f. Podiatric appliances for prevention of 14 complications associated with diabetes.

15 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. g. Podiatric health care provider services 16 as are deemed medically necessary to prevent complications 17 from diabetes.

18 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. h. Other medications, devices, appliances, 19 and equipment approved by the United States food and drug 20 administration for the treatment of diabetes or its 21 complications, and prescribed or recommended as medically 22 necessary by the patient's physician.

EXPLANATION

This bill amends Code section 514C.18, relating to 25 insurance coverage for diabetes.

The bill provides that a policy or contract providing for third-party payment or prepayment of health or medical expenses shall provide coverage for costs associated with certain medications, equipment, and supplies for the treatment do f diabetes mellitus, if such items are prescribed by a licensed physician.
