## A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for phosphorus use levels in calculations
2 required to determine the application of manure in manure 3 management plans, and making penalties applicable.

Section 1. Section 455B.203, subsection 3, paragraph a, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:
a. Calculations necessary to determine the land area required for the application of manure from a confinement feeding operation. The calculations shall be based on nitrogen and phosphorus use levels in order to obtain optimum crop yields according to a crop schedule specified in the plan, and according to requirements adopted by the department after receiving recommendations from the animal agriculture consulting organization provided for in 1995 Iowa Acts, chapter l95, section 37.

## EXPLANATION

This bill amends Code section 455B.203, which provides requirements for manure management plans submitted by owners of confinement feeding operations or persons applying manure originating from confinement feeding operations. The Code section provides that the plan must include calculations necessary to determine the amount of land needed for the application of the manure. The calculations are currently based on nitrogen use levels needed to obtain optimum crop yields. This bill provides that the calculations must also be based on phosphorus use levels. Generally, a person submitting a manure management plan who is found in violation of the terms and conditions of the plan is subject to a civil penalty of not more than $\$ 5,000$.
