A BILL FOR 1 An Act relating to the appointment and qualifications of an executive director of a county commission of veteran affairs. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: Я

- Section 1. Section 35B.6, subsection 1, paragraphs a and 2 b, Code 2001, are amended to read as follows:

 a. The members of the commission shall qualify by taking 4 the usual oath of office, and give bond in the sum of five 5 hundred dollars each, conditioned for the faithful discharge 6 of their duties with sureties to be approved by the county 7 auditor. The commission shall organize by the selection of
- 8 one of their members as chairperson, and one as secretary.
- 9 The commission, subject to the approval of the board of 10 supervisors, shall-have-power-to may employ an executive
- 11 director and other necessary administrative or clerical
- 12 assistants when needed, the compensation of such the employees
- 13 to be fixed by the board of supervisors, but no member of the
- 14 commission shall be so employed. The executive director must
- 15 possess the same qualifications as provided in section 35B.3
- 16 for commission members. However, -this-qualification
- 17 requirement-shall-not-apply-to-a-person-employed-as-an
- 18 executive-director-prior-to-July-1,-1989.
- 19 b. Upon the employment of an executive director, the
- 20 executive director shall complete a course of initial training
- 21 provided by the commission of veterans affairs pursuant to
- 22 section 35A.3. If-an-executive-director-is-not-appointed,-a
- 23 commissioner-or-a-clerical-assistant-shall-complete-the-course
- 24 of-training. The commission shall issue the executive
- 25 director,-commissioner,-or-clerical-assistant a certificate of
- 26 training after completion of the initial training course. To
- 27 maintain annual certification, the executive director,
- 28 commissioner,-or-elerical-assistant shall attend one
- 29 commission training course each year. Failure to maintain
- 30 certification may be cause for removal from office. The
- 31 expenses of training shall be paid from the appropriation
- 32 authorized in section 35B.14.
- 33 Sec. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT. Section 25B.2, subsection
- 34 3, does not apply to the requirements of this Act.
- 35 EXPLANATION

This bill provides that each county commission of veteran 2 affairs shall appoint an executive director who shall be a 3 veteran as defined in Code section 35.1. Two or more counties 4 may share an executive director, but a commissioner or a 5 clerical assistant shall not be substituted for an executive 6 director to carry out the duties of the county commission of 7 veteran affairs as allowed by current law. Code section 25B.2, subsection 3, relating to the funding 9 of state mandates, does not apply to the requirements of this 10 bill.
