EXPLANATION

21 This bill amends provisions related to the workforce 22 development fund.

The bill amends one of the specific uses of the moneys in the workforce development fund related to training and retraining programs for targeted industries. The bill provides that the moneys may instead be used for training, retraining, and educational initiatives for targeted industries as recommended by the Iowa new economy council. The bill provides that, of the moneys in the workforce development fund, \$1,850,000 shall be used for purposes related to training, retraining, and educational initiatives for targeted industries; \$4,500,000 shall be used for purposes of the job training fund; \$1,050,000 shall be used for purposes of the high technology apprenticeship program; and \$600,000 shall be used for purposes of business network

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
