## A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring motor vehicle operators to change lanes when 2 passing stationary authorized emergency, towing, recovery, and 3 highway maintenance vehicles and providing a penalty. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

34 stationary towing, recovery, or highway maintenance vehicle.
35 The bill requires the operator of an approaching motor

1 vehicle, absent another direction from a peace officer, to 2 change lanes to a lane that is not adjacent to the stationary 3 vehicle if the vehicle is traveling on a highway with more 4 than one lane traveling in the same direction as the motor 5 vehicle and the lane change is possible in the existing safety 6 and traffic conditions. The requirement only applies when the 7 stationary vehicle is displaying the appropriate flashing 8 lights.
9 The bill also makes a violation of the new requirement a 10 simple misdemeanor punishable by a scheduled fine of $\$ 35$.
