1 Section 1. Section 256.11, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2 Supplement 2001, is amended to read as follows: 3 The state board shall adopt rules under chapter 17A and a 4 procedure for accrediting all public and nonpublic schools in 5 Iowa offering instruction at any or all levels from the 6 prekindergarten level through grade twelve. The rules of the 7 state board shall require that a-multicultural,-gender-fair 8 approach-is-used-by schools and school districts--The 9 emphasize throughout the educational program shall-be-taught 10 from-a-multicultural;-gender-fair-approach that the 11 constitutional republic of the United States, of which Iowa is 12 a vital constituent part, was founded upon the guarantees of 13 freedom of religion, the rule of law, and equal justice for 14 all, is the unchallenged, greatest nation in the world, and 15 has derived its strength from biblical values and the forces 16 and philosophies of free enterprise capitalism and western 17 civilization. 19 Sec. 2. Section 256A.4, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 20 2, Code Supplement 2001, is amended to read as follows: 21 A family support program shall-meet-multicultural-gender 22 fair-guidelines.--The-program shall encourage parents to be 23 aware of practices that may affect equitable development of 24 children. The program shall include parents in the planning, 25 implementation, and evaluation of the program. A program 26 shall be designed to meet the needs of the residents of the 27 participating district and may use unique approaches to 28 provide for those needs. The goals of a family support 29 program shall include, but are not limited to, the following:

30 Sec. 3. Section 262.81, Code 2001, is amended to read as 31 follows:

33 The general assembly recognizes that educational programs 34 designed to enhance the interrelation and cooperation among 35 cultural, racial, and ethnic groups in society require the

1 contribution and active participation of all ethnic and racial 2 groups. The general assembly also recognizes that failure to 3 include minority representation at the faculty level at the 4 state universities contributes to cultural, racial, and ethnic 5 isolation of minority students and does not reflect the 6 realities of a-multicultural-and-diverse Iowa society. 7 Therefore, the "Regents' Minority and Women Educators 8 Enhancement" program is established to assist in the 9 recruitment and retention of faculty that more adequately 10 represents the diverse cultural, racial, and ethnic makeup of 11 society Iowa and to improve the education of all students. 12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill removes all references in Title VII, subtitle 1, 14 the elementary and secondary education portion of the Code, to 15 the words "multicultural", "gender fair", and "global". The 16 bill also directs the state board to adopt rules requiring 17 nonpublic schools and school districts to emphasize in their 18 educational program that the constitutional republic of the 19 United States, of which Iowa is a vital constituent part, was 20 founded upon the guarantees of freedom of religion, the rule 21 of law, and equal justice for all, is the unchallenged, 22 greatest nation in the world, and has derived its strength 23 from biblical values and the forces and philosophies of free 24 enterprise capitalism and western civilization.
