## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to telephone solicitations, and providing for a
2 civil penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 476B.1 DEFINITIONS.
- 2 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
- 3 requires:
- 4 1. "Basic local telephone service" means the same as
- 5 defined in section 476.96.
- 6 2. "Nonresidential customer" means a person, other than a
- 7 residential customer, who is furnished with telecommunications
- 8 service by a telecommunications utility.
- 9 3. "Nonsolicitation directory" means the directory
- 10 established under section 476B.2.
- 11 4. "Residential customer" means an individual who is
- 12 furnished with basic local telephone service by a
- 13 telecommunications utility, but does not include an individual
- 14 who operates a business at the individual's residence.
- 15 5. "Telephone solicitation" means the unsolicited
- 16 initiation of a telephone conversation for the purpose of
- 17 encouraging the recipient of the telephone call to purchase
- 18 goods or services.
- 19 6. "Telephone solicitor" means a person, other than a
- 20 nonprofit organization or an employee or contractor of a
- 21 nonprofit organization, that employs or contracts with an
- 22 individual to make a telephone solicitation. For purposes of
- 23 this chapter, "telephone solicitor" includes both the employer
- 24 and the employee actually making the telephone call.
- 25 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 476B.2 NONSOLICITATION DIRECTORY --
- 26 LISTING.
- 27 l. The secretary of state shall adopt rules for
- 28 establishing, maintaining, and semiannually updating a
- 29 directory that includes listings of residential customers who
- 30 do not wish to receive telephone solicitations made by
- 31 telephone solicitors. The rules adopted pursuant to this
- 32 section shall establish requirements and procedures for a
- 33 residential customer to request a listing in the
- 34 nonsolicitation directory. Upon request by a residential
- 35 customer, the secretary of state shall include in the

- 1 nonsolicitation directory a listing indicating that the
- 2 residential customer does not want to receive any telephone
- 3 solicitation made by a telephone solicitor. The rules shall
- 4 also require a residential customer who requests a listing in
- 5 the directory to notify the secretary of state on a biennial
- 6 basis if the residential customer wishes to continue to be
- 7 included in the directory. The secretary of state shall
- 8 eliminate a residential customer from the directory if the
- 9 customer does not make the biennial notification.
- 2. Except for copies of the nonsolicitation directory that
- 11 are provided to registered telephone solicitors, the
- 12 nonsolicitation directory is not subject to inspection,
- 13 copying, or receipt and may not be released by the secretary
- 14 of state, notwithstanding any Code provision to the contrary.
- 15 3. The secretary of state shall, on a semiannual basis,
- 16 make the nonsolicitation directory available by electronic
- 17 transmission only to telephone solicitors who are registered
- 18 under section 476B.3. Upon the request of a telephone
- 19 solicitor registered under section 476B.3, the secretary of
- 20 state shall also provide a printed copy of the nonsolicitation
- 21 directory to the telephone solicitor. A telephone solicitor
- 22 who receives a copy of the directory, or to whom the directory
- 23 is made available by electronic transmission under this
- 24 paragraph, may not solicit or accept from any person, directly
- 25 or indirectly, anything of value in exchange for providing the
- 26 person with any information included in the directory, and
- 27 shall not otherwise divulge the information in the directory
- 28 to a third party.
- 29 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 476B.3 REGISTRATION OF TELEPHONE
- 30 SOLICITORS -- LIMITATIONS ON TELEPHONE SOLICITORS.
- 31 l. The secretary of state shall adopt rules that require
- 32 any telephone solicitor who requires an employee or contractor
- 33 to make a telephone solicitation to a residential customer in
- 34 this state to register with the department, obtain a
- 35 registration number from the department, and pay a

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- 1 registration fee to the department. The amount of the
- 2 registration fee shall be based on the cost of establishing
- 3 the nonsolicitation directory, and the amount that an
- 4 individual telephone solicitor is required to pay shall be
- 5 based on the number of telephone lines used by the telephone
- 6 solicitor to make telephone solicitations. The rules shall
- 7 also require a telephone solicitor that registers with the
- 8 department to pay an annual registration renewal fee to the
- 9 department. The amount of the registration renewal fee shall
- 10 be based on the cost of maintaining the nonsolicitation
- 11 directory.
- 12 2. A telephone solicitor may not do either of the
- 13 following:
- 14 a. Make a telephone solicitation to a person in this state
- 15 unless the telephone solicitor is registered with the
- 16 secretary of state under the rules adopted pursuant to this
- 17 section.
- 18 b. Make a telephone solicitation that does any of the
- 19 following:
- 20 (1) Uses an electronically prerecorded message in
- 21 telephone solicitation without the consent of the recipient of
- 22 the telephone call.
- 23 (2) Makes a telephone solicitation to a residential
- 24 customer if the nonsolicitation directory that is provided or
- 25 made available to the telephone solicitor under section 476B.2
- 26 includes a listing for the residential customer.
- 27 (3) Makes a telephone solicitation to a nonresidential
- 28 customer if the nonresidential customer has provided notice by
- 29 mail to the telephone solicitor that the nonresidential
- 30 customer does not wish to receive telephone solicitations.
- 31 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 476B.4 REQUIRED DISCLOSURES.
- 32 1. An individual who makes a telephone solicitation shall
- 33 identify at the beginning of the telephone conversation each
- 34 of the following:
- 35 a. The name of the telephone solicitor making the call.

- 1 b. If different than the telephone solicitor, the person
- 2 selling the goods or services, or receiving the contribution,
- 3 donation, grant, or pledge of money, credit, property, or
- 4 other thing of any kind, that is the reason for the telephone
- 5 solicitation.
- 6 2. A telephone solicitor that makes a telephone
- 7 solicitation to a nonresidential customer shall, upon the
- 8 request of the nonresidential customer, provide the mailing
- 9 address for notifying the telephone solicitor that the
- 10 nonresidential customer does not wish to receive telephone
- 11 solicitations.
- 12 Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. 476B.5 EXCEPTIONS.
- 13 A telephone solicitation that satisfies either of the
- 14 following is not subject to this chapter:
- 15 1. The telephone solicitation is made to a recipient in
- 16 response to the recipient's request for the telephone
- 17 solicitation.
- 18 2. The telephone solicitation is made to a recipient who
- 19 is a current client of the person selling the goods or
- 20 services. This paragraph does not allow affiliates of the
- 21 person selling the goods or services to make a telephone
- 22 solicitation unless the recipient is also a current client of
- 23 such affiliate.
- 24 Sec. 6. NEW SECTION. 476B.6 TERRITORIAL APPLICATION.
- 25 This chapter applies to any interstate telephone
- 26 solicitation received by a person in this state and to any
- 27 intrastate telephone solicitation received by a person in this
- 28 state.
- 29 Sec. 7. NEW SECTION. 476B.7 ENFORCEMENT.
- 30 The attorney general may bring an action for temporary or
- 31 permanent injunctive or other relief for any violation of this
- 32 chapter.
- 33 Sec. 8. NEW SECTION. 476B.8 PENALTY.
- 34 A person who violates any provision of this chapter shall
- B5 be required to pay a civil penalty of one hundred dollars for

1 each violation.

2 EXPLANATION

- This bill creates a new Code chapter pertaining to 4 telephone solicitations.
- 5 New Code section 476B.2 requires the secretary of state to
- 6 create a nonsolicitation directory that lists the residential
- 7 telephone customers who have indicated they do not want to
- 8 receive any telephone solicitations. The directory is updated
- 9 semiannually, and residential customers must reaffirm their
- 10 intent to remain on the list every two years, or else be
- 11 deleted from the list. The list is provided only to
- 12 registered telephone solicitors, primarily in electronic
- 13 format, but also in printed format upon request. The
- 14 telephone solicitor may not sell the information.
- New Code section 476B.3 requires all telephone solicitors
- 16 to register and pay a fee. The fees paid will be based on the
- 17 cost of maintaining the nonsolicitation directory. Telephone
- 18 solicitors are prohibited from making a telephone solicitation
- 19 without registering, making a telephone solicitation that uses
- 20 an electronically prerecorded message without the recipient's
- 21 consent, making a telephone solicitation to a residential
- 22 customer on the nonsolicitation directory, and making a
- 23 telephone solicitation to a nonresidential customer who has
- 24 provided notice by mail to the telephone solicitor that the
- 25 nonresidential customer does not wish to receive telephone
- 26 solicitations.
- 27 The telephone solicitor is required to disclose at the
- 28 beginning of the call the name of the telephone solicitor
- 29 making the call and the name of the person selling the goods
- 30 or services. The telephone solicitor also, upon the request
- 31 of a nonresidential customer, shall provide the mailing
- 32 address for notifying the telephone solicitor that the
- 33 nonresidential customer does not wish to receive telephone
- 34 solicitations.
- 35 Telephone solicitations made to existing clients or in

1 response to requests are not subject to new Code chapter 476B. New Code chapter 476B applies to intrastate telephone 3 solicitations and interstate telephone solicitations received 4 by an Iowa resident. A violation of new Code chapter 476B is punishable by a 6 civil penalty of \$100 for each violation. The attorney 7 general may bring an action for a temporary or permanent 8 injunction or other relief for any violation.
