A BILL FOR

An Act limiting the amount of contributions a candidate for office may accept from outside the candidate's elective district, and providing for a civil penalty.

Section 1. Section 56.5A, Code 2001, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 3. a. A candidate's committee shall not 3 4 accept contributions from sources other than eliqible electors 5 within the district represented by the office to which the 6 candidate presently seeks election, unless the candidate's 7 committee has received and deposited in the candidate's 8 campaign account an equal or greater total of contributions 9 from eliqible electors within the district represented by the 10 office to which the candidate presently seeks election. b. A candidate who accepts a contribution in violation of 11 12 this subsection shall be fined civilly in an amount equal to 13 ten times the amount by which the contribution exceeded the 14 permitted limit. The fine proceeds shall be deposited in the 15 Iowa election campaign fund created in section 56.19. 16 **EXPLANATION** 17 This bill amends Code chapter 56 to restrict a candidate's 18 committee in its acceptance of contributions from sources 19 other than eligible electors within the candidate's district. 20 A candidate could accept funds from such sources only up to 21 the amount of funds that the candidate has collected from 22 eliqible electors within the candidate's district. The penalty for violation of this limitation would be a 23 24 civil fine equal to 10 times the amount accepted in excess of 25 the limit. 26 Pursuant to Code section 68B.32D, the fine could be imposed

27 by the ethics and campaign disclosure board if it were no more
