However, the scheduled fine specified in 8 section 805.8, subsection 5, paragraph "e", does not apply to 9 a violation of this chapter or a rule for which another 10 scheduled fine is specified in section 805.8, subsection 5. 11 Sec. 2. Section 483A.42, Code 2001, is amended to read as 12 follows: 483A.42 PENALTIES. 13 A person who violates this chapter is quilty of a simple 14 15 misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation under section 16 805.8, subsection 5, paragraph "e".
