- 29 The bill provides that the notification requirement does
- 30 not apply to the use of outdoor fire for cooking or
- 31 recreation, burning of normal yard waste, training fires, or
- 32 disaster waste fires, except for in certain cities; if burning
- 33 normal yard waste is enclosed in an incinerator or a large
- 34 container; or to a location which is under an open burn
- 35 prohibition imposed by the state fire marshal.

3 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than 30\,
4 days or a fine of at least $50 but not more than $500, or by
