Section 331.321, subsection 3, Code 2001, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: Except as otherwise provided by state law, a person 4 appointed to-a-county-office as provided in subsection 1 may 5 be removed by the officer-or-body-making-the-appointment;-but 6 the-removal-shall-be board by written order. The order shall 7 give the reasons and be filed in the office of the auditor, 8 and a copy shall be sent by certified mail to the person 9 removed who, upon request filed with the auditor within thirty 10 days of the date of mailing the copy, shall be granted a 11 public hearing before the board on all issues connected with 12 the removal.
