## S.F. 363 H.F.

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 1C.12 JUNETEENTH NATIONAL 2 FREEDOM DAY. The governor of this state is hereby authorized and 4 requested to issue annually a proclamation designating the 5 third Saturday in June as "Juneteenth National Freedom Day" 6 and to encourage all governmental bodies in the state to 7 observe the day in a manner that emphasizes the meaning and 8 importance of the Emancipation Proclamation, which ended 9 slavery in the United States, and to recognize that the oldest 10 known celebration of the end of slavery occurred on or about 11 that date. 12 EXPLANATION 13 This bill authorizes and requests the governor to issue 14 annually a proclamation designating the third Saturday in June 15 as "Juneteenth National Freedom Day".
