BIRTH INJURY PREVENTION RESEARCH AND EDUCATION. 2 There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to 3 the state board of regents for the fiscal year beginning July 4 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, the following amount, or so 5 much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose 6 designated:

7 For the establishment of a birth injury prevention research 8 and education program at the university of Iowa hospitals and 9 clinics:

This bill provides for an appropriation from the general fund of the state to the state board of regents for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, of 3 \$300,000 for the establishment of a birth injury prevention research and education program at the university of Iowa hospitals and clinics. The bill provides that the appropriated funds shall be used to analyze current research relating to birth injury prevention; conduct additional research relating to the treatment and prevention of birth injuries; provide physician education concerning the causes, incidence, and prevention of birth injuries; and prepare and listribute updates to physicians and hospitals relating to 2 current birth injury treatment options.
