BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 473.20, subsection 1, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

1. The department may make loans to the state, state agencies, political subdivisions of the state, school districts, area education agencies, community colleges, and nonprofit organizations for implementation of energy conservation measures identified in a comprehensive engineering analysis. Loans shall not-be-made-for-energy conservation-measures-that-require-more-than-an-average-of-six years-for-the-statey-state-agencyy-political-subdivision-of the-state;-school-district;-area-education-agency;-community collegey-or-nonprofit-organization-as-an-entity-to-recomp-the sctual-or-projected-cost-of-construction-and-acquisition-of the-improvements; and-cost-of-the-engineering-plans-and specifications be made for all cost effective energy management improvements. For the state, state agencies, political subdivisions of the state, school districts, area education agencies, community colleges, and nonprofit organizations to receive a loan from the fund, the department shall require completion of an energy management plan including an energy audit and a comprehensive engineering

analysis. The department shall approve loans made under this section.
