NAT. RES. & ENVIRONMENT

1 Section 1. Section 455B.310, Code 2001, is amended by
2 adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 10. A county in which a privately
4 operated sanitary landfill accepts solid waste from outside of
5 the county may charge an additional tonnage fee for the
6 disposal of all solid waste at the sanitary landfill. The
7 additional fee charged and the moneys collected shall be used
8 exclusively by the county for the development and
9 implementation of alternatives to sanitary landfills, for the
10 costs incurred by the county to abate problems associated with
11 the operation of the sanitary landfill, or for inspections of
12 the sanitary landfill by the county.

13 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
14 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides that a county, in which a privately
17 operated sanitary landfill accepts solid waste from outside of
18 the county, may charge an additional tonnage fee for disposal
19 of all solid waste at the sanitary landfill. The moneys
20 collected shall be used for the development and implementation
21 of alternatives to sanitary landfills, for the abatement of
22 problems associated with the operation of the sanitary
23 landfill, or for inspections of the sanitary landfill by the
24 county.

25 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
