3 317.25 TEASEL, MULTIFLORA ROSE, AND PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE 4 PROHIBITED -- EXCEPTIONS.

5 A person shall not sell, offer for sale, or distribute 6 teasel (Dipsacus) biennial, the multiflora rose (rosa 7 multiflora), purple loosestrife (lythrum salicaria), purple 8 loosestrife (lythrum virgatum), or seeds of them in any form 9 in this state. However, this section does not prohibit the 10 sale, offer for sale, or distribution of the multiflora rose 11 (rosa multiflora) used for understock for either cultivated 12 roses or ornamental shrubs in gardens. EXPLANATION

27 Currently, the sale, offer for sale, or distribution of 28 purple loosestrife (lythrum virgatum) is allowed under certain 29 circumstances and there is a recordkeeping requirement for 30 such sales and distribution. This bill prohibits the sale, 31 offer for sale, or distribution of purple loosestrife (lythrum 32 virgatum) and removes the related recordkeeping requirements. 33




