1 An Act regulating unformed manure storage structures associated with animal feeding operations, making a penalty applicable, and providing an effective date. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: SF 89 AGRICULTURE

1 Section 1. Section 455B.161, Code 2001, is amended by 2 adding the following new subsection:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 6A. "Authorized animal feeding operation 4 structure" means a confinement building, egg washwater storage 5 structure, or formed manure storage structure.

6 Sec. 2. Section 455B.162, subsection 2, unnumbered 7 paragraph 1, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

8 Except as provided in subsection subsections 3B and 6, and 9 sections 455B.163 and 455B.165, this subsection applies to 10 animal feeding operation structures constructed on or after 11 January 1, 1999, but prior to the effective date of this Act, 12 and to the expansion of structures constructed on or after 13 January 1, 1999, but prior to the effective date of this Act. 14 The following table represents the minimum separation distance 15 in feet required between an animal feeding operation structure 16 and a residence not owned by the owner of the animal feeding 17 operation, or a commercial enterprise, bona fide religious 18 institution, or an educational institution:

13 A person shall not construct or expand an unformed manure 14 storage structure on or after the effective date of this Act. 15 Sec. 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of 16 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

## EXPLANATION

This bill amends provisions concerning unformed manure storage structures related to animal feeding operations. The bill amends provisions in Code chapter 455B which regulate animal feeding operations and related structures. Specifically, the bill creates a new Code section 455B.207, which prohibits a person from constructing or expanding an unformed manure storage structure on or after the effective date of the bill. An unformed manure storage structure includes an anaerobic lagoon or earthen manure storage basin. The bill makes corresponding changes in sections requiring separation distances between objects or locations and animal peeding operation structures.

According to Code section 455B.191, a person who violates 31 Code section 455B.207, as enacted in the bill, is subject to a 32 civil penalty of \$5,000.
