18	percent of breast cancer patients will get lymphedema
19	after surgery and radiation; and
20	WHEREAS, according to the National Cancer
21	Institute, a reported 8.5 million Americans are living
22	after a diagnosis of cancer, of which about 2 million
23	are breast cancer survivors; and
