1 and shall include additional members as nonvoting, ex 2 officio members, including but not limited to 3 representatives from the area education agencies, 4 accredited public and nonpublic schools, accredited 5 private postsecondary institutions, community 6 colleges, institutions of higher education under the 7 control of the state board of regents, cities, and 8 counties; and 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the charge of the 10 committee shall be to estimate the savings and 11 revenues the state could realize from joining the 12 compact; identify the costs of joining the compact, 13 both in membership dues and as Iowa students cross 14 Iowa's borders to attend institutions in other states; 15 review the resources the compact offers, programs 16 sponsored by the compact, and the program agreements 17 reached; and examine examples of regional cooperation 18 and innovation in the delivery of educational 19 services; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the interim study 20 21 committee shall submit its findings and 22 recommendations in a report to the General Assembly by 23 December 15, 2004. 24 25 26 27 28 29 30
