A Concurrent Resolution honoring N. William Hines on his retirement as Dean of the University of Iowa College of Law.

WHEREAS, N. William Hines is retiring as Dean of the University of Iowa College of Law on June 30, 2004, after completing 28 years of service in that position; and

WHEREAS, Dean Hines has served in that position longer than any other Dean of the Iowa College of Law and has served as Dean of the Iowa College of Law longer than any current dean of any other law school has served in that position; and

WHEREAS, the length of his service as Dean is impressive, but not nearly as impressive as the enormous accomplishments of the Hines' deanship; and

WHEREAS, the quality, diversity, and national visibility of the University of Iowa College of Law has been dramatically enhanced over the last 28 years, and during his deanship Dean Hines has devised, initiated, facilitated, or orchestrated these impressive beneficial developments; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That the Iowa General Assembly pays tribute to Dean N. William Hines for his enormous contribution to legal education and the University of Iowa College of Law during his service as Dean and congratulates him for the many beneficial improvements to that institution during his tenure; and
