HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1 2 BY SHOULTZ 3 A Concurrent Resolution designating March 16 annually 4 as Liberty Day. WHEREAS, we, as citizens of the United States of 5 6 America, enjoy liberties established in and derived 7 from documents that our founding fathers created, 8 including the Declaration of Independence and the 9 United States Constitution containing the Bill of 10 Rights; and WHEREAS, James Madison was the author of the 11 12 Virginia Plan, which served as the model for and basis 13 of the forming of a new Constitution at the 14 Constitutional Convention of 1787, establishing our 15 new form of government in place of the Articles of 16 Confederation; and WHEREAS, James Madison was the author of the 17 18 Federalist Papers, which were a series of newspaper 19 articles outlining the reasons why states should 20 endorse the new Constitution; and 21 WHEREAS, James Madison served in the United States 22 House of Representatives from 1789 until 1797, during 23 which time he introduced into Congress the Bill of 24 Rights; and WHEREAS, James Madison served as President of the 25 26 United States from 1809 until 1817; and 27 WHEREAS, March 16, 2003, is the two hundred fifty-28 second anniversary of the birth of James Madison; NOW 29 THEREFORE, 30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
