1 Section 1. Section 400.17, unnumbered paragraph 3, Code
2 2003, is amended to read as follows:

3 Employees shall not be required to be a resident of the
4 city in which they the employees are employed~~7-but-they-shall~~
5 ~~become-a-resident-of-the-state-at-the-time-such-appointment-or~~
6 ~~employment-begins-and-shall-remain-a-resident-of-the-state~~
7 ~~during-employment.~~ Cities may set reasonable maximum
8 distances outside of the corporate limits of the city that
9 police officers, fire fighters, and other critical municipal
10 employees may live.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill strikes a requirement that city civil service
13 employees must reside within this state during their civil
14 service employment.
