1 Section 1. Section 298.3, subsections 3 and 10, Code 2003, 2 are amended to read as follows:

3 3. The purchase-of-buildings-and-the purchase, lease, or
4 lease-purchase of a single unit of equipment or technology
5 exceeding five hundred dollars in value per unit.

6 10. Lease-purchase <u>The purchase of buildings or lease-</u>
7 <u>purchase</u> option agreements for school buildings and-for

10 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of 11 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. 12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill relates to permissible uses for physical plant 14 and equipment levy revenue and eliminates conflicting and 15 duplicative language.

Prior to the 2002 Legislative Session, Code section 298.3, subsection 3, provided that physical plant and equipment levy revenue may be expended for the purchase of buildings and the purchase of a single unit of equipment or a technology system exceeding \$1,500 in value. Legislation enacted in 2002 changed this subsection, providing for the lease or leasepurchase of a single unit of equipment or technology and lowering the value of the equipment or technology being acquired to exceeding \$500. This change appears to conflict with Code section 298.3, subsection 10, which provides that revenue may be expended for lease-purchase option agreements for school buildings and for equipment exceeding \$5,000 per single unit.

To eliminate this apparent conflict, the bill places the oprovisions relating to the acquisition of buildings, and of equipment or technology, into two separate subsections. Code section 298.3, subsection 3, is modified to remove any reference to the purchase of a building, such that the subsection relates only to the purchase, lease, or leasepurchase of a single unit of equipment or technology exceeding

1 \$500 per unit. Code section 298.3, subsection 10, is modified 2 to remove any reference to equipment or technology or 3 reference to \$5,000 per single unit and add the provision for 4 the purchase of buildings that was removed from subsection 3. The bill takes effect upon enactment.
