A BILL FOR 1 An Act changing the annual deadline for establishing the state percent of growth for school district budgets, and providing an effective date. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 257.8, subsection 1, Code 2003, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- STATE PERCENT OF GROWTH. The state percent of growth
- 4 for the budget year beginning July 1, 2002, is one percent.
- 5 The state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July
- 6 1, 2003, is two percent. The state percent of growth for each
- 7 subsequent budget year shall be established by statute which
- 8 shall be enacted within-thirty-days-of-the-submission during
- 9 the thirty-day period immediately preceding the last calendar
- 10 date on which per-day expenses of office would be payable
- 11 during a regular session of the general assembly as provided
- 12 in section 2.10, in the year preceding the base year of-the
- 13 governor's-budget-under-section-8.21. The establishment of
- 14 the state percent of growth for a budget year shall be the
- 15 only subject matter of the bill which enacts the state percent
- 16 of growth for a budget year.
- 17 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
- 18 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- 20 This bill changes the deadline by which the state percent
- 21 of growth for school district budgets is annually required to
- 22 be established by statute. Code section 257.8 currently
- 23 provides that the state percent of growth shall be enacted
- 24 within 30 days of the submission of the governor's budget in
- 25 the year preceding the base year. The bill provides that for
- 26 the purposes of determining the state percent of growth for
- 27 the budget year beginning July 1, 2004, and succeeding budget
- 28 years, the deadline shall be changed to enactment during the
- 29 30-day period immediately preceding the last calendar date on
- 30 which per-day expenses of office would be payable during a
- 31 regular session of the general assembly as specified in Code
- 32 section 2.10 in the year preceding the base year. The
- 33 practical effect of this change would be to delay the
- 34 requirement for establishing the state percent of growth from
- 35 the initial 30 days of each legislative session to the final
