 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
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- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 135C.31A ASSESSMENT OF RESIDENTS
- 2 -- PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY.
- 3 l. A licensed health care facility shall determine, prior
- 4 to initial admission of a resident, the prospective resident's
- 5 eligibility for benefits through the United States department
- 6 of veterans affairs. The health care facility shall also
- 7 determine the eligibility of any residents residing in the
- 8 facility if a determination was not made prior to a resident's
- 9 admission to the health care facility. The health care
- 10 facility shall report any information collected to the Iowa
- 11 commission of veterans affairs.
- 12 2. The department shall require as a condition of renewal
- 13 of licensure under this chapter that a health care facility
- 14 provide accurate documentation of compliance with this
- 15 section.
- 16 3. The department shall adopt rules to implement and
- 17 administer this section.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- 19 This bill requires that a licensed health care facility
- 20 determine, prior to initial admission of a resident, the
- 21 prospective resident's eligibility for benefits through the
- 22 United States department of veterans affairs. The bill also
- 23 requires that the health care facility determine the
- 24 eligibility of current residents if a determination was not
- 25 made prior to a resident's admission. Under the bill, the
- 26 health care facility is to report any information collected to
- 27 the Iowa commission of veterans affairs. The bill also
- 28 provides that as a condition of renewal of licensure of a
- 29 health care facility, the health care facility is to provide
- 30 accurate documentation of compliance with the requirements of
- 31 the bill.

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
