Description

House File 125 increases the amount of the license fee the county treasurer retains for county issuance of a driver's license or nonoperator's identification cards from \$3.75 to \$4.25.

Assumptions

- 1. Under current law, it is estimated that 31.0%, or approximately 267,000 licenses or identification cards, will be issued by counties per year.
- 2. The counties retain \$3.75 per issuance or renewal, for a total of approximately \$1.0 million collected annually.

Fiscal Impact

The estimated fiscal impact of raising the collection fee on 267,000 licenses or identification cards issued by counties from \$3.75 to \$4.25 is a decrease in revenues of \$134,000 annually to the Road Use Tax Fund, and an increase in revenues of \$134,000 annually to the counties' General Fund.
