- 1 Section 1. Section 514C.18, subsection 1, Code 2003, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraphs:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Medications approved by the United
- 4 States food and drug administration for the control of blood
- 5 sugar levels, including insulin and oral agents, prescribed by
- 6 the patient's physician.
- 7 NEW PARAGRAPH. d. Equipment and supplies necessary for
- 8 insulin administration, including but not limited to syringes,
- 9 insulin pens, insulin pumps, and related equipment.
- 10 NEW PARAGRAPH. e. Assistive devices for those who are
- ll visually impaired, including but not limited to voice-
- 12 modulated blood glucose meters and injection aids.
- 13 NEW PARAGRAPH. f. Podiatric appliances for prevention of
- 14 complications associated with diabetes.
- 15 NEW PARAGRAPH. g. Podiatric health care provider services
- 16 that are deemed medically necessary to prevent complications
- 17 from diabetes.
- 18 NEW PARAGRAPH. h. Other medications, devices, appliances,
- 19 and equipment approved by the United States food and drug
- 20 administration for the treatment of diabetes or its
- 21 complications, prescribed or recommended as medically
- 22 necessary by the patient's physician.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 This bill amends Code section 514C.18, relating to
- 25 insurance coverage for diabetes.
- 26 The bill provides that a policy or contract providing for
- 27 third-party payment or prepayment of health or medical
- 28 expenses shall provide coverage for costs associated with
- 29 certain medications, equipment, and supplies for the treatment
- 30 of diabetes mellitus, if such items are prescribed by a
- 31 licensed physician.

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
