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A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to protests of assessment on certain residential
2 property.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 441.37, Code 2003, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. If an aggrieved taxpayer obtains an
- 4 appraisal of the property for purposes of a protest under this
- 5 section or section 441.35, the costs associated with obtaining
- 6 the appraisal shall be paid from the assessment expense fund
- 7 if all of the following apply:
- 8 a. The property for which the value is protested is
- 9 classified as residential property and the taxpayer resides on
- 10 the property.
- 11 b. The assessment which is the subject of the protest
- 12 exceeds the previous year's assessment by at least twenty-five
- 13 percent.
- 14 c. The household income of the aggrieved taxpayer is such
- 15 that would qualify the aggrieved taxpayer for assistance under
- 16 the federal low-income home energy assistance program.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill provides that if a taxpayer protests the
- 19 assessment of the taxpayer's residence and obtains an
- 20 appraisal of the residence for the purposes of making the
- 21 protest, the assessor shall pay the costs associated with
- 22 obtaining the appraisal if the taxpayer's household income
- 23 qualifies the taxpayer for assistance under the federal low-
- 24 income home energy assistance program and if the assessment
- 25 protested exceeds the previous year's assessment on the
- 26 property by 25 percent or more.

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
