**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act establishing a special breast cancer awareness motor  
2 vehicle registration plate and appropriating fees from such  
3 plates for breast cancer screening.

1 Section 1. Section 321.34, Code 2003, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 23. BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PLATES.

4 a. An owner referred to in subsection 12, upon written  
5 application to the department, may order special registration  
6 plates with a breast cancer awareness emblem. The emblem  
7 shall be designed by the department and shall contain an image  
8 of a pink ribbon.

9 b. The special fee for letter number designated breast  
10 cancer awareness plates is thirty-five dollars. The special  
11 fee for personalized plates is twenty-five dollars, which  
12 shall be paid in addition to the special fee of thirty-five  
13 dollars. The annual special fee for letter number designated  
14 breast cancer awareness plates is ten dollars and the annual  
15 special fee for personalized plates is fifteen dollars, which  
16 shall be paid in addition to the regular annual registration  
17 fee.

18 c. The fees collected by the director under this  
19 subsection shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and  
20 credited to the road use tax fund. Notwithstanding section  
21 423.24, and prior to the crediting of revenues to the road use  
22 tax fund under section 423.24, subsection 1, paragraph "b",  
23 the treasurer of state shall transfer monthly from those  
24 revenues to the Iowa department of public health the amount of  
25 the special fees collected in the previous month for the  
26 breast cancer awareness plates. The Iowa department of public  
27 health shall distribute one hundred percent of the funds  
28 received monthly in the form of grants to support breast  
29 cancer screenings for both men and women who meet eligibility  
30 requirements like those established by the Susan G. Komen  
31 foundation. In the awarding of grants, the Iowa department of  
32 public health shall give first consideration to affiliates of  
33 the Susan G. Komen foundation and similar nonprofit  
34 organizations providing breast cancer screenings in Iowa.  
35 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys transferred under this

1 subsection shall not revert to the general fund of the state.

2     Sec. 2. CONSULTATION. The state department of  
3 transportation shall consult with the Susan G. Komen  
4 foundation in designing the emblem for the special breast  
5 cancer awareness plates as required in this Act.

6                                     EXPLANATION

7     This bill establishes a special breast cancer awareness  
8 motor vehicle registration plate to be issued by the state  
9 department of transportation. The plate will bear a processed  
10 emblem with an image of a pink ribbon signifying breast cancer  
11 awareness. The special fee for initial issuance of the plate  
12 is \$35 for letter number designated plates and \$60 for  
13 personalized plates. The annual special fee, to be paid in  
14 addition to the regular annual registration fee, is \$10 for  
15 letter number designated plates and \$15 for personalized  
16 plates.

17     The treasurer of state is directed to transfer the special  
18 fees from breast cancer awareness plates to the Iowa  
19 department of public health. The department shall distribute  
20 100 percent of the funds in the form of grants to Iowa  
21 affiliates of the Susan G. Komen foundation or similar  
22 nonprofit organizations operating in Iowa to be used for  
23 breast cancer screening for men and women who meet eligibility  
24 requirements like those established by the Komen foundation.
