- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 459.606 MORATORIUM --
- 2 CONSTRUCTION OF CONFINEMENT FEEDING OPERATION STRUCTURES.
- 3 1. As used in this section, "construction" of a
- 4 confinement feeding operation structure means the same as
- 5 defined in section 459.201 and includes the expansion of a
- 6 confinement feeding operation structure.
- 7 2. Except as provided in subsection 3, all of the
- 8 following shall apply:
- 9 a. A person shall not construct a confinement feeding
- 10 operation structure.
- ll b. The department shall not issue a permit as otherwise
- 12 provided in section 459.303 for the construction of a
- 13 confinement feeding operation structure.
- 3. Subsection 2 does not apply to any of the following:
- 15 a. Construction of a confinement feeding operation
- 16 structure, if after construction the confinement feeding
- 17 operation is a small animal feeding operation.
- 18 b. Construction of a confinement feeding operation
- 19 structure that does not increase the maximum animal unit
- 20 capacity of the confinement feeding operation.
- 21 c. Construction that is ordered by the department in order
- 22 to remedy a clear, present, and impending danger to the public
- 23 health or the environment.
- 24 d. Construction of a confinement feeding operation
- 25 structure that begins prior to the effective date of this Act.
- 26 4. A person who violates this section shall be subject to
- 27 a civil penalty which shall be established, assessed, and
- 28 collected in the same manner as provided in section 455B.109.
- 29 5. This section is repealed on July 1, 2004.
- 30 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
- 31 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 32 EXPLANATION
- 33 This bill amends Code chapter 459 regulating animal feeding
- 34 operations including confinement feeding operations. A
- 35 confinement feeding operation is an agricultural facility

- 1 containing buildings in which animals are confined and fed and
- 2 maintained for 45 days or more in any 12-month period.
- 3 The bill prohibits a person from constructing, including
- 4 expanding, a confinement feeding operation structure, defined
- 5 to mean a confinement building or associated manure storage
- 6 structure or egg washwater storage structure. The bill also
- 7 prohibits the department of natural resources from issuing a
- 8 permit for the construction of such a structure.
- 9 The bill provides exceptions to the prohibition. The
- 10 prohibition does not apply to: (1) a small animal feeding
- 11 operation; (2) construction that does not increase the maximum
- 12 animal unit capacity of the confinement feeding operation; (3)
- 13 construction that is ordered by the department of natural
- 14 resources to remedy a public emergency; and (4) construction
- 15 that begins prior to the effective date of the bill.
- 16 According to the bill, construction first occurs on the
- 17 earliest of the following dates: site excavation,
- 18 installation of concrete forms, or installation of piping for
- 19 manure control. Construction also includes the expansion of
- 20 existing structures.
- 21 A person who violates a provision of the bill is subject to
- 22 a civil penalty of up to \$10,000.
- The prohibition ends on July 1, 2004, by repeal of new Code
- 24 section 459.606.
- 25 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
