Section 1. Section 89A.3, Code 2003, is amended by adding
 2 the following new subsection:
      NEW SUBSECTION. 6. The commissioner shall adopt rules
 4 permitting elevators which are permitted for residential use
 5 to be used in an eligible church or house of worship where the
6 elevators are only used to transport a restricted number of
7 persons with special needs. The rules shall provide that an
8 elevator installed pursuant to this subsection shall be
9 inspected upon the installation of the elevator and shall not
10 be subject to any further inspection. For purposes of this
11 subsection, an "eligible church or house of worship" means a
12 church or house of worship located in a building constructed
13 prior to July 1, 2003, and with a building capacity of five
14 hundred or fewer persons.

                             EXPLANATION
16
      This bill requires the labor commissioner to adopt rules
17 allowing residential elevators in eligible churches where the
18 elevators are only used to transport a restricted number of
19 persons with special needs. The bill further provides that
20 once an elevator has been installed as permitted by this bill,
21 it shall be subject to inspection only once. The bill defines
22 eligible churches as churches in buildings constructed prior
23 to July 1, 2003, with a building capacity of 500 or fewer
24 persons.
